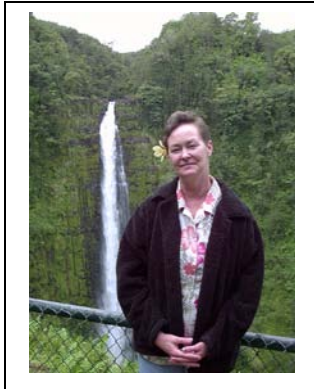


TSgt Sandee Lawrence

TSgt Sandee Lawrence, USAFR (Ret), passed away on October 31, 2009, after succumbing to pneumonia and related complications following a relatively short, rapidly progressive, and debilitating battle with COPD-emphysema. Sandee leaves her husband, MAJ Dan Lawrence, 129th Civil Engineer Squadron, her children Rodney Baang, Cristian Baang, Kelsie Mishima, and their families; and her step-children Matthew Lawrence, Cheri Lawrence, and their families. She also leaves six grandchildren.
