
HIGH FLIGHT

*CDMUND MATHIAS PETRACEK, age 87 of Santa Ana, California, passed away on August 22, 2009. Edmund was born on November 16, 1921 in Vesta, Redwood County, Minnesota. His parents were Frank and Magdalena (Kramer) Petracek. Edmund grew up in a farming family with three brothers and two sisters. Times were hard during the great depression but there was strong support from the extended family, the community and the Catholic Church. • Edmund had a rich military career starting with his enlistment as a cadet in the US Air Corp. in December, 1941. He served as a test pilot at Williams Field, Arizona and other US locations. He was honorably discharged as a 1st Lieutenant in November, 1945. He went on to become a member of the Air Force National Guard in California and retired from the Guard in 1976 with the rank of Lt. Colonel. In civilian life, he remained connected to his love of flying by becoming an airways operations specialist working in the tower at Burbank Airport and the International Oakland Airport. Throughout his careers Edmund received many commendations, citations and letters of appreciation. During Edmund's cadet training in Santa Ana he met Ruth LaMar Liggett. They married on May 28, 1943 in Hope, Arkansas. After the war they lived in California where they raised their daughter and three sons. They shared sixty years of married life until Ruth's death in 2003. • He is survived by his sons Michael, Steven and Gregory, his daughter Elizabeth, his brothers Donald and Francis, and sister Mary Ann De Sutter. In addition he leaves many nieces and nephews. Edmund was predeceased by his wife Ruth, brother Clarence, sister Patricia and many friends. • Edmund bad many roles in his long life, first as a farm boy, then as busband and father. But above all he was a flyer. May the heavens open for his spirit to soar with his comrades of old.
