ALBATROSS SERVED HONORABLY

Initially developed for the Navy in 1947, the "Albatross" was adopted by the USAF and designated the SA-16. One of the first USAF pilots to be trained to fly this aircraft was * Mel Woolcock; one of our own 129th AHA members. (Mel has a great story about how he joined the 129th as an "IP".)

Although best known for its search and rescue mission, the aircraft was also used for liaison, general transport, medivac, and even anti-submarine missions by many air forces around the world. (The 129th flew the SA-16 from 1957-1964 approximately.) The aircraft was configured to carry a crew of 4 - 6. It was powered by two (2) R-1820-76 or -82 radial engines, it could gross out at up to 35,700 pounds, max speed was 265 mph with normal cruise at 150-160 mph. Many SA/HU-16s are flying today as "private" aircraft. One was used recently as a "chase plane" for the re-creation of Amelia Earhart's "Flight Around the World".

P. S. You’ve got to hear Rose’s “Chicken Ranch” story.

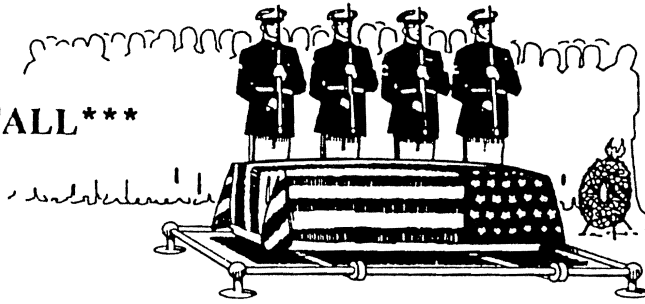

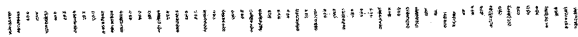

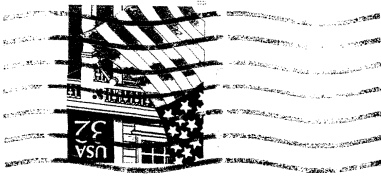
OLD TIMER'S LUNCHEON — "Great Fun"
