Change of Command

Col Steven Speer Departs 129th RQW

Major General William Lynch, the Adjutant General of Pennsylvania, announced Col Steven Speer as his selection as the new Commander of the 193rd Special Operations Wing at Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. The 193rd SOW has recently acquired all the geographically separated units in Pennsylvania and put them under the command of the 193rd, bringing the wing strength to over 1,800 personnel. The unit is undergoing conversion to the EC-130J and is working toward acquisition of 8 new aircraft. These specially modified Psychological Warfare Operations aircraft are usually the first aircraft in and the last ones out. They are the heaviest C-130s of all the various models and are in-flight refuelable. The change of command took place Sunday, November 7, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

Col Tommy Williams has assumed command of the 129th RQW. The formal change of command took place Sunday, December 5. A dinner was held on Saturday, December 4, at the Hyatt.

Cold War Certificates

In accordance with section 1084 of the Fiscal Year 1998 National Defense Authorization Act, the Secretary of Defense approved awarding Cold War Recognition Certificates to all members of the armed forces and qualified federal government civilian personnel who faithfully and honorably served the United States any time during the Cold War Era, defined as September 2, 1945, to December 26, 1991.

How do you apply for your Certificate?

To apply for your own (or for a deceased service member's) certificate, you must send a copy of proof of service and your request to the following address:

Be sure to include your return address!

What constitutes proof of service?

Acceptable documents for proof of service include any official government of military document with recipient's name, Social Security Number, Military Service Number, or Foreign Service Number. **Reminder:** Send copies ONLY. The source document(s) WILL NOT be returned.

Due to the remarkable success of this program, turn around time for mailing certificates may take as long as six months. The CWRS Operations Team is working as fast as possible to clear the backlog. Please do not request feedback prior to six months from the request date.

It has been my privilege and pleasure to work with Colonel Speer for these past two years, and I am sure I speak for all the AHA members in wishing him success in his new assignment.



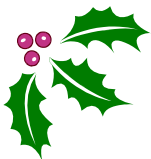
